The following points were discussed in the governing body meeting held on 11-12-2025.

1. Admissions for the Academic year 2025-26: The Chairman of the Governing body explained and declared that Admissions made for the Academic year 2025-26 and concluded by the number of admissions that in UG (B.Pharmacy course 68 admissions made out of 100 and 31 students had joined in PG (both Pharmaceutics & Pharmaceutical Analysis) branches. Unity College of Pharmacy had better admissions in contrast to other colleges. Governing body approved this discussion.

2. Curbing of ragging in the institute The chairman of the Governing body explained the menace of ragging has been satisfactorily controlled in the institute and there is not even a single case reported against this evil practice during the current academic year. The steps taken by us are very effective and could not be violated. We have formed various committees with the senior members, who used to take care internally and externally, putting vigilance at all vulnerable points.

Beside above, we have displayed pamphlets in bold letters, enlightening the drastic punishments, including expulsion and rustication from the college, if anybody venture indiscreetly, and indulge himself with freshers in a way which constitute misbehavior. Due to persistent efforts, by the staff and management, the institute is bearing a stamp of discipline which is also free from ragging. The Governing body of the institute has approved this note.

3. Examination Results in both UG and PG:

The chairman of the Governing body explained that, the B. Pharmacy I, II, III & IV Sem II sems semester end exams has completed and class work commenced already for next semester. In outgoing batches B.Pharmacy final year students passed out with 91% and M.Pharmacy students passed out with 79%. The Governing body has approved this agenda.

4. Placement Details:

For the Academic year 2025-26, we have invited and conducted three times placement drives from **MSN Laboratories, Hetero Drugs Ltd and Medplus**. Among these placement drives **14** students has recruited in **MSN Laboratories**, **09** students in **Hetero Drugs** and **31** students has recruited in **Medplus**. The package is **2.8L** in **MSN** and **Hetero Drugs** and **2.4L** in **Medplus**. The Governing body has approved this agenda.

5. PCI Approval status:

The chairman of the Governing body explained that the Approval for the Academic Year 2025-26 already issued by Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) and approval for the coming academic year 2026-27 already application has submitted in this month (Last date is 15.12.2025). After inspection from

esteemed PCI we will get the Approval for the Academic Year 2026-27. The Governing body has approved this agenda.

6. Submission of NAAC AQAR Report for the year 2024-25

The chairman of the Governing body explained, our institution accredited with NAAC with Grade 'A'. Already for the Academic Year 2023-24 NAAC submitted the AQAR (Annual Quality Assurance Report). The NAAC has under introducing two new phases of reforms i.e BAF (Binary Accreditation Frame work) and MBGL (Maturity Based Grading Level). Once the NAAC announces we will submit the AQAR for the year 2024-25 and 2025-26. We would submit within the prescribed time. The Governing body has approved this agenda.

7. Application to UGC for 2(f) and 12(B)

The chairman of the Governing body explained that our Unity College of Pharmacy has applied for UGC recognition; in this regard we have submitted a proposal to Registrar, JNTUH. The Registrar JNTUH has approved and forwarded our proposal to UGC on 16.09.2025. And we have received a letter from UGC asking from some clarification on 12.11.2025. We are on that work and once it finished we will submit to the UGC. The Governing body has approved this agenda

8. Participation in NIRF

The Chairman has explained this item that for this academic year i.e 2025-26, we have already registered and waiting for the announcement from NIRF. Once the NIRF announces for filling the data, we will complete within stipulated time. The Governing body has approved this minute.
